Perpetua and Felicitas 7 March d. 203 Catechumens and Martyrs

★ Arrested as catecumens
★ Persecution under Severus designed to stop the

growth of Christianity and Judaism

★ Given many chances to recant their faith
★ Wounded by beasts (a mad cow, in deference to

their gender), executed by the sword

Perpetua's husband curiously absent from story
